### IBM® DB2® for i Post 6.1 and 7.1 Enhancements

Release 7.1 is now generally available. The release is chock full of a wide variety of database enhancements such as XML support, performance improvements, and enablement for data encryption. A significant number of enhancements have also been PTFed to releases prior to 7.1 such as Solid State Disk (SSD) support and new table functions. Come get an overview of these database enhancements including a demo of some of latest System i Navigator features.

**Mark Anderson** - Mark is a Distinguished Engineer and chief architect for DB2 for i.

In this role, he has primary technical responsibility for the architecture, design, and implementation of DB2 for i. Mark was primarily responsible for the first SQL implementation on AS/400 (for which he received a Corporate Award).

Mark is a member of the IBM Information Management Architecture Board which is responsible for setting future database directions across the DB2 Family. Mark is frequently engaged to design database solutions to solve partner and customer requirements and problems.
